Workforce Learning Link is...

A unique computer-based program designed to move people from unemployment back to employment or to improve opportunities for people already in the workforce.

The primary goal is to help participants attain a level of self sufficiency and ultimately enrich their lives through career advancement and lifelong learning.

The program can also help:

- increase reading and mathematics skills
- increase computer skills
- increase communication skills
- increase overall readiness to enter the workforce or advance to further training



Learning Opportunities

- Adult Basic Education (ABE)
- General Education Development (GED)
- English as a Second Language (ESL)
- Personal Computer Basics (PCB)



Eligibility Requirements

- Must be legally eligible to work in the United States
- Must demonstrate a need for basic skills enhancement
- Must identify an attainable goal and/or outcome
- ABE: Must have a minimum of a 4th grade reading, math, and language level on the TABE test
- GED: Must have a minimum of a 8th grade reading, math, and language level on the TABE test
- ESL: Must have a minimum score of 439 on the BEST Plus test
